## What is a Community Reference Group?

The purpose of a Community Reference Group is to offer reflection and feedback on the needs and views of the community.

Our Community Reference Group meets across Sunbury and the Macedon Ranges and is made up of a diverse group of people from these communities.

We regularly consult the community to gather important feedback about our services that we can use in program development and strategic planning.

Membership of the Community Reference Groups is voluntary, however, we do ask for commitment to attend meetings over a two-year period if possible.

## How does it work?

The Community Reference Group meets four times per year. We meet online and in person. The purpose of these meetings is for members of the community to:

- Inform us of community concerns and interests.
- Give feedback on our communications and messages to the community.
- Advise on new program or project developments.
- Help us to improve the quality of existing programs and services.
- Identify new opportunities for community participation.
- Contribute to the development of advocacy and activism campaigns.
